## How Does it Work?

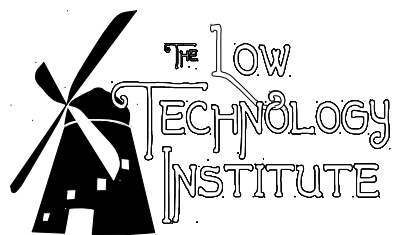
A tool library works just like a book library: come in and borrow the tools you need for the task you're working on for free.
